Grading Policy: Your grade will be determined as follows:

4 Tests.....60% (each test is comprehensive to last topic covered)

Final Exam.....20% (comprehensive)

All online work.....10% (online homework 5%; online quizzes 5%)

The lowest scores on online homework and quizzes will be dropped at the end of the term.

The score on the final will replace the lowest test score, if it is to your advantage. However, the final will NOT replace a 0 that you get for missing a test.

Make-up Policy: There are no make-up for tests. If you miss a test due to a verifiable legitimate excuse (documentation required), then your final exam will count in place of the missing test. In this case, the option of replacing the lowest test score will not apply.
